DISTANCE LEARNING

The North East School Division (NESD) encourages students to participate in face-to-face instruction. However, in some circumstances it may be beneficial and necessary for students to enroll in distance learning.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Part-time online students:
 - a. Approval of part-time online course requests will be given to students who possess the independent ability to meet minimum requirements of courses that support a legitimate need, a graduation plan and are not offered by the school or cannot be taken due to scheduling conflicts.
 - b. Students interested in taking online classes may contact their school administration for approval. Once approved, the principal or designate will register the student with the online school.
 - c. NESD school support of part-time online learners shall align with the <u>Quality Assurance</u> <u>Framework for K-12 Online Learning, 2023</u>.

2. Full-time online students:

- a. NESD students can enroll full-time with any provincially approved online provider.
- b. Full-time online students enrolled with the SaskDLC and approved catholic or francophone online schools are permitted access to NESD services:
 - Full-time online students are permitted access to common educational resources, such as libraries, provided they do not interfere with school-based operations.
 - ii. Full-time online students are permitted access to driver education through the school in their attendance area.
 - iii. Full-time online students may participate in extracurricular activities providing:
 - 1. Participation adheres to school-based extra-curricular processes and expectations.
 - 2. Participation fees and travel costs are born by the parent.
 - 3. Participation in any extracurricular activity can be ended at the discretion of the principal.
