KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

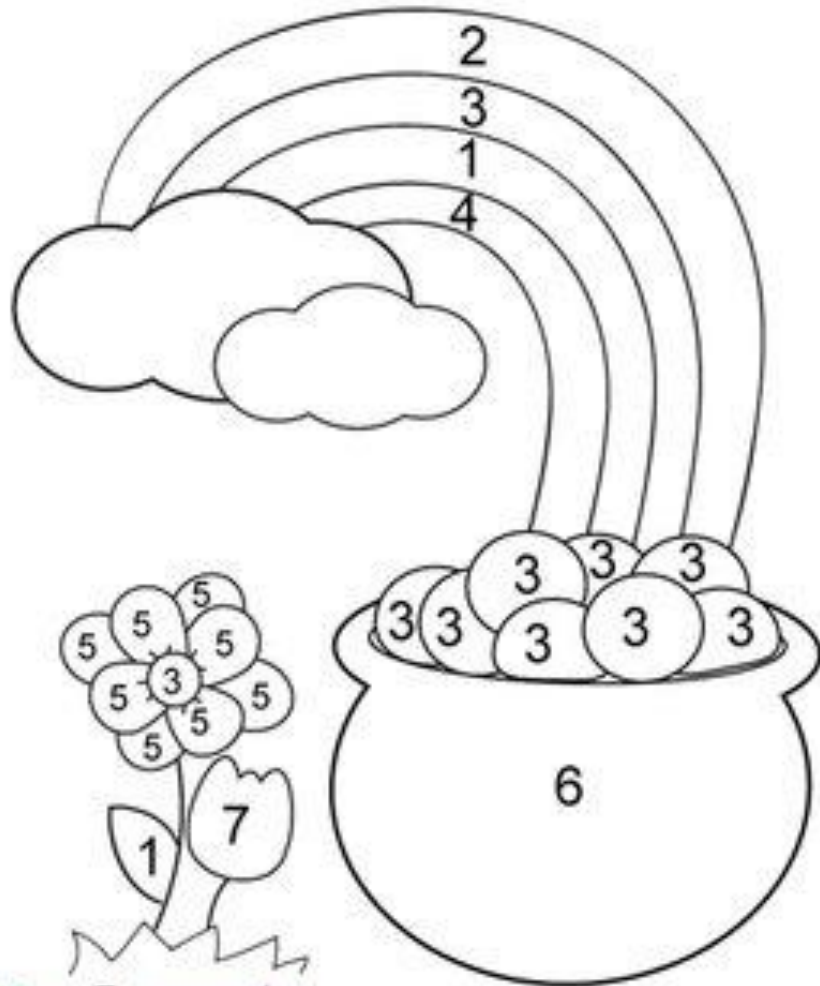
