Tips with Tasha CPES Counseling Consultant

Does your child just say "it was ok" when you ask how school was? Instead, try to ask, "Were there any sad parts in your day?" "Were there any funny parts of your day?" "Were there any frustrating or hard parts of your day?" "Were there any proud parts of your day?" By asking about specific emotions, you are helping your child to recognize emotions throughout his or her day and express themselves. Eventually, there is a high chance that after you ask your child how their day was, they will highlight the same emotions you've been asking about. Gradually, you can include a variety of emotions or specific ways you would like to improve communication on such as: honesty, connection with peers, frustration (re: academics), etc. It will be tempting to solve any problems that arise in their stories but try to just listen for now. Asking your child for clarification and repeating what you've heard back to them to check for understanding are some positive tools in active listening; these strategies are not controlling in the sense of providing a solution to any 'frustrating stories'. However, if your child asks for advice or help on a topic, that is your ticket to intervene-- on that one topic.

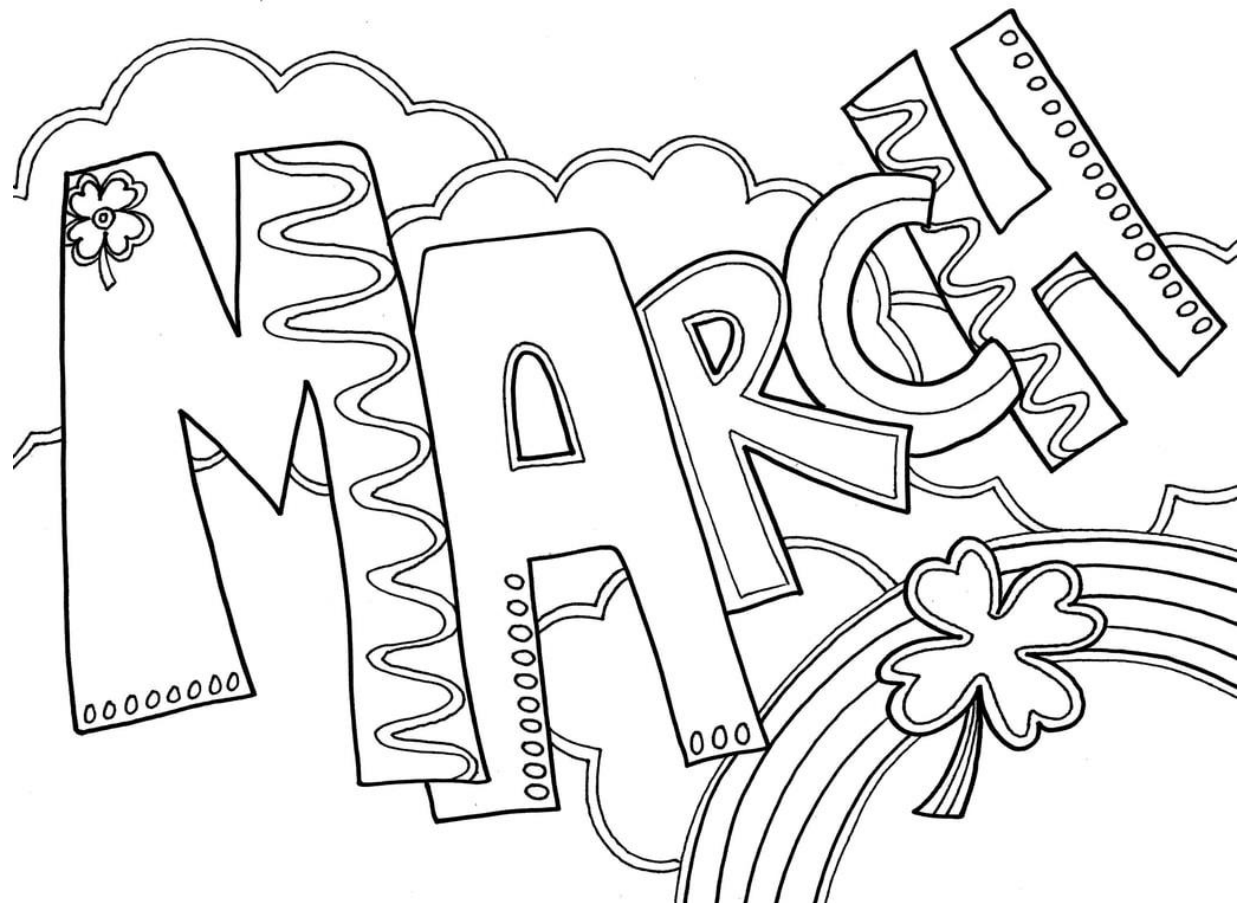
