Families, you can help your child by reading with them and to them at home every day! Thank you for your help and partnership to work with your children to create reading success. If you can read, you can succeed!

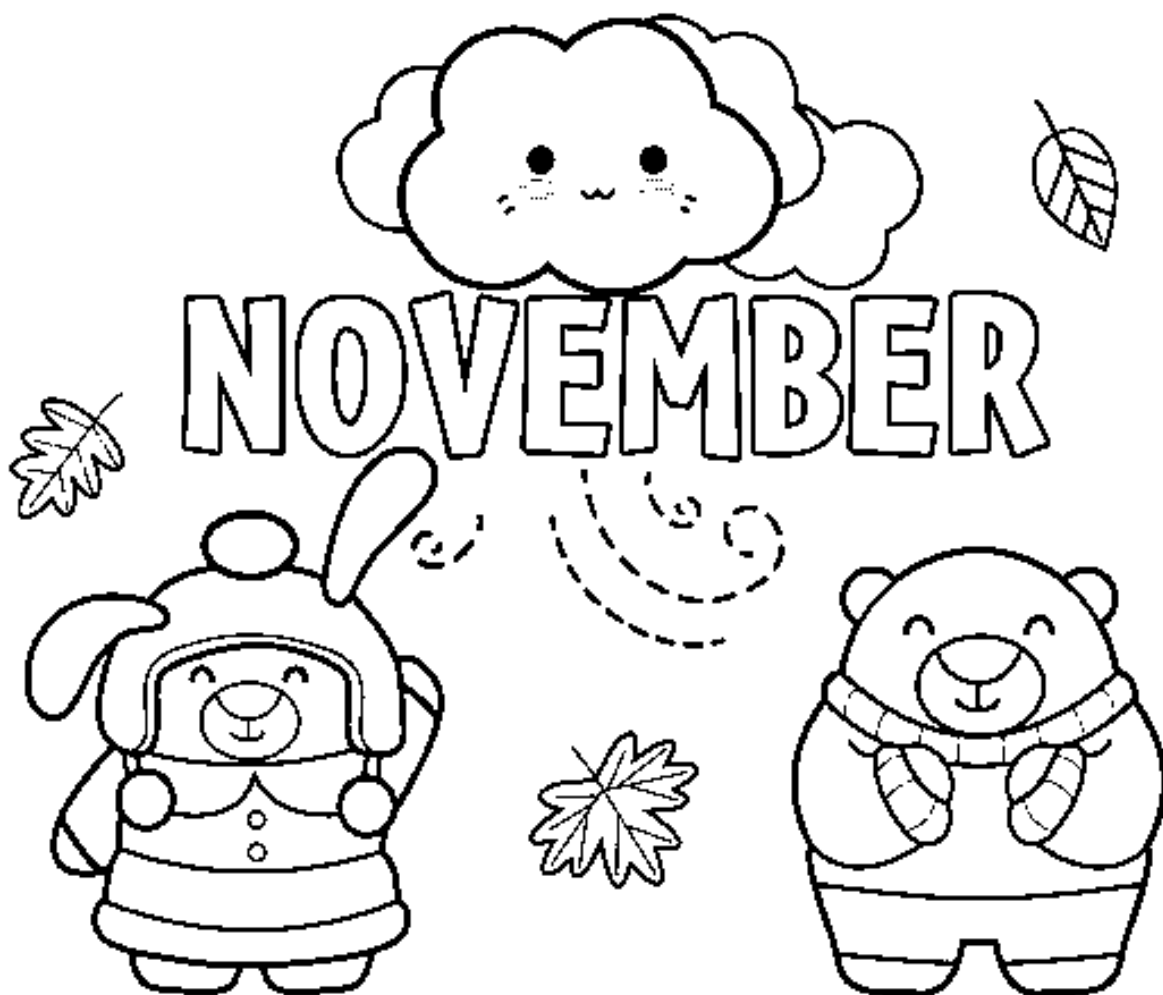
Fall Fundraiser
