No Donations Accepted at CPES...but there are other places to help! 😊

We have such a caring community, and many phone calls are coming in about this, but a reminder that this school year, we cannot accept donations from families...of winter clothing, regular clothing, books, toys, or games..... This is due to our school Covid-safety plan. We also cannot take any food, drink, or prepackaged food or snack items from families for class parties, etc. We also cannot take any donations for the Kids' Christmas Store. We will not be doing that project this year.

There are places families can donate to in Nipawin....

Nipawin Oasis Centre is currently taking donations of winter outerwear for children and adults. Drop off at the door, Monday to Friday, 9 - 4:30 pm.

Salvation Army takes donations of clothing and outer wear at their drop off spot at the back, Monday and Thursday, 10:00 - 4:30 pm. They also take books, toys, games, and other household items.

The Nipawin Family Resource Centre (at the Medical Group) is collecting toys and games, and items for Christmas gifts for children 0 - 18 for the Nipawin Secret Santa program (run by Jessica Griffin, on our SCC). Those items can be dropped off when the centre is open.

Emergency Planning for Central Park

The parent muster point for our school is the Nipawin Evergreen Centre. If we ever need to move our school to a lock down (no access, students are kept safe) or hold & secure (no access to school, but student learning continues) in case of an emergency, parents would be directed to go to the Evergreen to receive information.

This parent muster point is the same for all schools in Nipawin - CPES, Wagner, and LP Miller.
