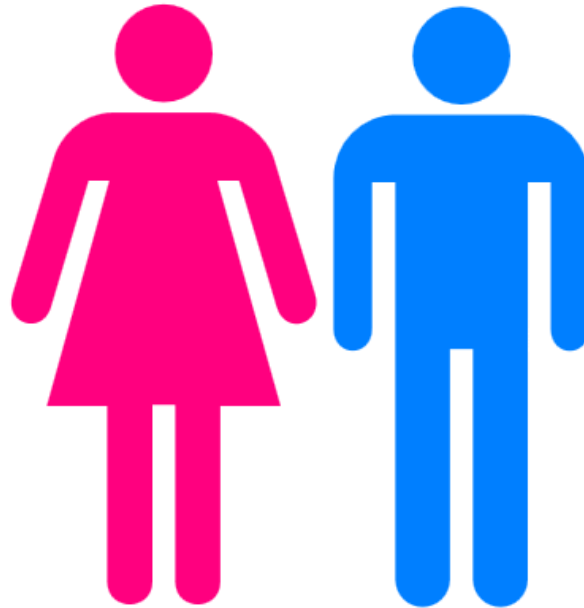


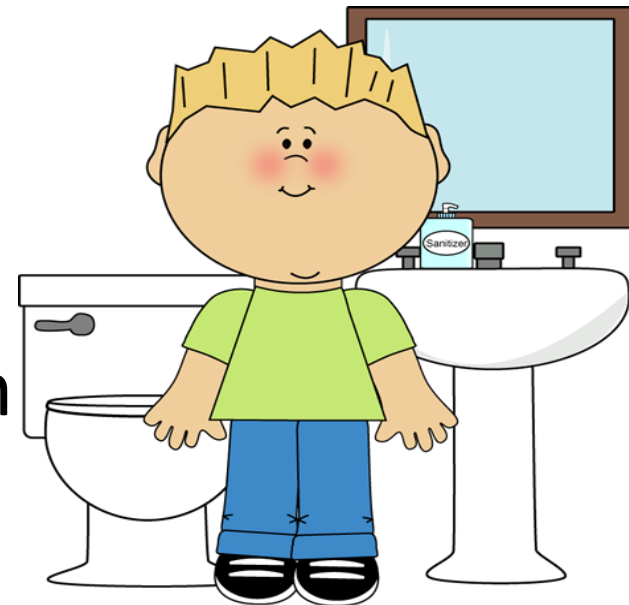
Bathroom Expectations



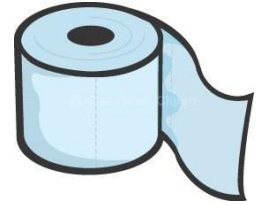
Respect and Responsibility
