When I Follow the Bus Expectations, I Am Able to...

- Have fun
- Be safe
- Show **Respect** and **Responsibility** for myself, others, for property, and for learning



When Lining up to Wait for the School Bus, I Will...

- Line up at the classroom door
- Wait quietly until I am dismissed – make sure to keep my hands and feet to myself
- Walk down the hallway, making sure to stay on the correct side
- Find my boots and put them on, being careful not to push or shove
- Be patient and take turns
- Use my inside voice
- Walk on the sidewalk to my bus line



When Waiting Outside For the Bus....

There are rules that I need to follow.

- Walk on the sidewalks to the bus line. Running could lead to injury.
- Be sure to listen to the supervisors outside who are checking to see who is going on the bus.
- Keep hands to myself and remain in my bus line. I will not use my backpack as something to hurt others with.

These rules allow myself and others to:

- Be safe
- Have fun
- Show respect and responsibility



At the Bus Stop Please Remember...

- The same rules apply at the bus stop as they do at our school. Be kind to other students waiting for the bus, respect the property in which you are waiting.
- You should not be playing amongst the trees, or throwing anything. It is important not to be at the bus stop too far ahead of time.



When I Wait in the School Bus Line..

- I will remember to walk down the sidewalk to my bus line that I am pre-assigned to wait at.
- When waiting, I will keep my hands to myself and remain quiet while the bus supervisor is calling my name to take attendance.
- I will not go out into the bus loop until I have been told it is safe to do so.

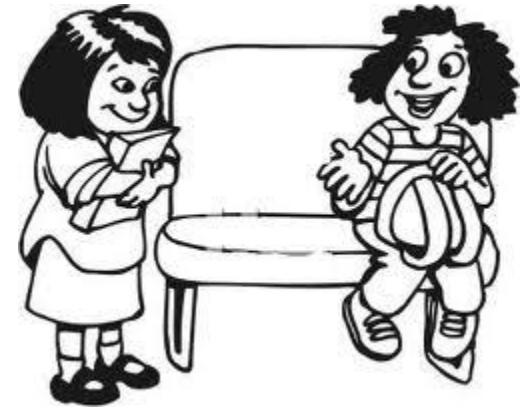
When Going onto the Bus, I Will Remember to...

- I will greet the bus driver by saying hello.
- I will carefully go up the stairs and be careful not to bump others with my backpack.
- I will go to my assigned seat or to an open seat.
- I will sit down and put my backpack on the floor in front of me or on my lap.



When Riding on the Bus, I will Remember to...

- To keep the bus clean.
- Use quiet voices.
- Follow the rules my bus driver has explained to me.
- Remain in my seat and keep my hands and feet to myself.



In the Winter, I Will Remember to...

- Always dress appropriately by wearing my ski pants, a warm hat and mittens. It can be cold waiting for the bus and it is important to be prepared if something happens to my bus.
- Wait at the bus stop and not throw snowballs.



When Leaving the Bus...

- I will remember to check my seat area and make sure that I have not left anything behind.
- When walking down the aisle I will keep my hands to myself and not push anyone.
- As I leave the bus, I will be sure to thank, and say good bye to my bus driver.
