

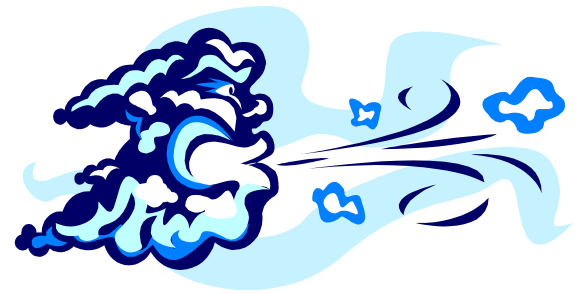

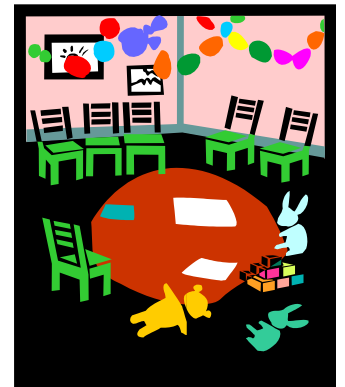
Respect and Responsibility

We can stay inside and have fun and be safe if we remember to:

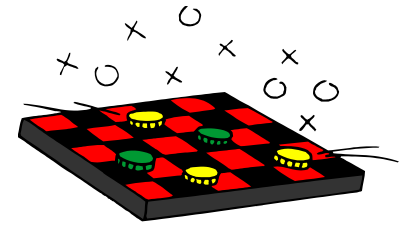
- use appropriate language

- If you need to use the washroom, ask the supervisor for permission
- Follow adult directions
- keep the classroom clean, organized, and litter-free

Inside Recess at Lunch

- **Before you play, eat your lunch and follow the expectations**
 - Eat your own lunch
 - Use manners
 - Stay in your desk, sit in your chair
 - Ask for a lunch early, from your homeroom teacher
 - Eat first, visit after
 - Only touch **your** lunch
 - Wait to be dismissed
 - Recycle your juice boxes (empty left over juice and throw the straw in the garbage)
 - Clean up before you start to play
 - If you have work to do, stay at your desk and do it first.
