## Safety First

## TE'S School Wind Chill Indicators

Just a reminder to parents that students **MUST** be dressed appropriately for outdoor play for the winter months. We ask that students have boots, ski pants, a warm jacket, toque, warm mitts as well as a scarf or neck warmer for really cold days. Fresh air, outdoor play and exercise are very important so please ensure your child is warm and comfortable for the winter months. Please label all

outdoors clothing with your child's name.

The following weather/wind-chill guide is used to determine how much time is spent outdoors:

- Warmer than  $-27$ —recess as usual
- Between  $-27$  to  $-34$  there will be 5-7 minutes of outdoor play
- $-35$  or lower, stay inside
