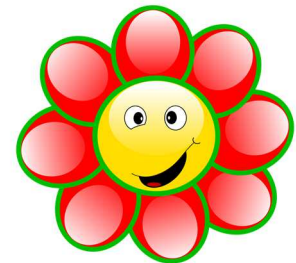

FABULOUS REMINDERS

- ◆ Students should not be arriving at school before 8:40. We currently have some students arriving at 8:30 with no supervision. Supervision starts at 8:40 and we want everyone to be safe! 
- ◆ As wet and cool conditions continue, please ensure your child is wearing appropriate footwear. Flip flops are not appropriate footwear for playground play as they become a safety issue when running and playing on structures. Thank you for sending closed toed shoes with your child. Thank you for ensuring your child's shoes are labelled with their name, as multiple students may have the same shoes!
- ◆ As temperatures continue to fluctuate, please ensure your kids have the proper outdoor clothing so they are comfortable and warm during outdoor play. Mittens, toque and an extra hoodie can be kept in their backpack and used when needed.
- ◆ We continue to have people walking through the bus loop and street area before and after school. Thank you for ensuring that you and your children are using the crosswalks and not going across when buses are entering and exiting to ensure your safety.

Saskatchewan's Pre-Kindergarten program admits children based on eligibility criteria. It is important to share as much information as possible about your child's growth and development as possible. Submitting this screening tool does not guarantee your child's enrolment in the program. Children must be 3 or 4 years of age before December 31, 2021. You will be contacted by the school division if your child qualifies for the program.
Deadline to apply is May 20/2021.
