

Grade 9 School Supplies 2018-19

- 3 (1.5 inch) binders for English and Social and Math
- 1 large multi-subject binder or 3 small binders
- 1 (1 inch) binder with dividers for Band or Art (no zipper binders for band please)
- 1000 sheets of loose leaf
- 2 packages of dividers
- 2 report covers
- 5 duo-tangs
- 5 pocket folders
- 1 Notebook 80-100 pages
- 15 pens (black or blue)
- 15 pencils
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 2 highlighters
- 4 white erasers
- 1 pencil case
- 1 -30cm clear plastic ruler
- 2 white-out
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 package of pencil crayons
- 1 package of fine tip markers
- 1 fine tip black sharpie (art students only)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 box of reinforcements
- 1 calculator (must have *pi* function)
- 1 geometry set
- 3 packages of recipe/index cards
- 1 box of Kleenex to be brought to the classroom on the first day of school.
- 1 change of phys. ed. clothing (shorts or sweats (NO SPANDEX) and t-shirt/tank top (NO SPAGETTI STRAPS))
- 1 pair of non-marking indoor running shoes to stay at school (NO BOARD SHOES)

It is suggested that each student bring:

- head phones for personal use while using a computer at the school
- USB thumb drive to use for transferring work between home and school.
- protective eye wear for Phys. Ed and intramurals; used for floor hockey and badminton.

Sewing 9:

Supplies are available in the lab or you can purchase supplies at Pearson's or Fabricland in Regina/PA/S'toon (Fabricland gives 10% discount if you tell them it is for school and show your student card or supply list).

The following items need to be stored in a container with a tight fitting lid (margarine, tupperware, Glad, etc.):

- a binder or section in a binder for notes and handouts
- straight pins in a container or a cushion (a cushion is best)
- seam ripper
- 1 hand sewing needle
- **thread if you want the colour to match your fabrics. Black or white thread is supplied
- 1 pkg.of 1" non-roll elastic for PJ pants

Fabric:

- Pencil case: 0.25m of cotton or poly-cotton or a "fat quarter" for quilting. Please wash and dry.
- Fleece Mitts: 0.25m of polar fleece. Please wash and dry.
- PJ Pants: Most students use flannel or polar fleece. Please avoid plaids. If you select fabric with a pattern or words that only go one way, you will need extra fabric.
 - 150cm/60" wide = 1.5 m
 - 115cm/45" wide = 2.5 m
 - Please wash and dry
