WHAT TO EXPECT AT TMSS

Classroom configurations:

Students will be in two homeroom groupings and they will be split into three groupings for Math and ELA. This means that students will be in different groups at various parts of the day, and during the core subjects of Math and ELA, there will be smaller class sizes.

Lockers

All student belongings (books, backpacks and jackets) are kept in lockers that are equipped with combination locks. **It is important that you do NOT share your locker combination with any other students.** In the fall you will receive 2 locks, one for your hallway locker and one for your Phys. Ed. locker. You will receive your hallway lock on Thursday, August 25th at the Parent information night. Both will have to be returned at the end of June 2017.

Noon Hour Lunch

Students are to eat their lunch in the commons area, in the RECplex, or in the STOP room at noon. There are microwaves available for student use. The concession has a variety of hot and cold food available at reasonable prices.

Intramurals

An exciting intramural program is available to students during the lunch period throughout the school year. Grade Six students can get involved in sports such as volleyball, basketball, or floor hockey depending on the season. Have fun while earning GP points.

Student Activities

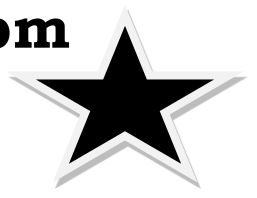
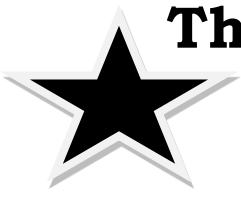
