Sask DLC Online courses not listed in the Education Plan (due Sept 15) will not be paid for by NESD.</p> <p>The Division Office will register your student into the Sask DLC Online courses.</p> <p>NESD is responsible for cost of online courses if part-time DLC status is stated in the September 15 Education Plan.</p> <p>No NESD Homeschool funding.</p> <p>Student remains a NESD Homeschool primary student and becomes a Sask DLC secondary student.</p>	<p>Student registers with the Homeschool by September 15.</p> <p>Education Plan submitted with registration by September 15 will include your child's intention of learning with full time distance learning courses, working toward a Sask Education High School Graduation Standing with 24 earned credits.</p> <p>The Division Office will register your student into the Sask DLC Online courses.</p> <p>No NESD Homeschool funding.</p> <p>NESD is responsible for cost of online courses if full-time DLC status is stated in the September 15 Education Plan.</p> <p>Sask DLC Online courses not listed in the Education Plan (due Sept 15) will not be paid for by NESD.</p> <p>Student becomes a Sask DLC primary student and the closest NESD local school becomes the student's secondary school, as per Sask DLC policy. The student is not considered a Homeschool student.</p>	<p>Student registers directly with Sask DLC Online. No NESD Homeschool funding.</p> <p>If Sask DLC notifies NESD by September 30 of full time registration, NESD is responsible for cost of online courses.</p> <p>If Sask DLC notifies NESD after September 30 of full time registration, family is responsible for cost of online courses.</p> <p>Student becomes a Sask DLC primary student and the closest NESD local school becomes the student's secondary school, as per Sask DLC policy. The student is not considered a Homeschool student.</p>	<p>Student registers at an NESD local school by September 1.</p> <p>No costs to the family.</p> <p>No NESD Homeschool funding.</p> <p>Registration in a Sask DLC Online course or courses may be deemed necessary based on vetting process.</p>
